More on the Church as God's Team...

"In football they have a huddle, the goal of the huddle is to give you thirty seconds to call the play, that is why they give you a huddle. (At a professional game there may be) Sixty thousand watching you huddle, they don't mind you taking thirty seconds to call the play. They understand that you have to get organized, you have to know where you are going to go, the ends need to know where they are going to go, the quarterback needs to know where he is going to go, the backs need to know where they are going to go. A huddle is a necessary part of playing the game. But let me inform you if you do not already know, sixty thousand people do not pay \$20 a ticket to watch you huddle. See, people don't come to football games to watch the huddle. They want to see if their team can overcome the opposition who is daring them to snap the ball and move down the field to score. What they want to know is does your practice work? Now what Christians often do is get high on their huddles. We gather together on Sunday morning and Sunday nights and Wednesday nights and we go nuts over the huddle! We say, "Boy did we have a huddle! My quarterback can call plays better than your guarterback." And boy do we go off on the huddle, but what people don't seem to understand is, that the huddle is so that we can play the game. The effectiveness of your church cannot be measured by how well you do on Sunday morning, ... The test of the church is what it does in the marketplace. What we need today is churches that are representative of Jesus Christ not only when gathered but when disseminated." (Dr. Tony Evans. "The (Sermon, 1987—Church Growth Power of God's People." College Football's Biggest Loss

It was the most brutally devastating rout in the history of College Football. On a dark and dreary Saturday in 1916...1 look at the 2 teams showed the trouble that was ahead....on one side towered GA Tech's Yellow Jackets...The local papers described them as "semi-human monsters," and "gorilla-like behemoths.'

They were coached by John Heisman—the man for whom college football's highest award is named. Heisman was a fanatic. He would not allow his players to use soap or water because he considered them debilitating. He wouldn't let them eat pastries, pork, veal, hot bread, nuts, apples, or drink coffee.

His reason? When asked, growl...."they don't agree with me...so they'd better not agree with you."

On the other side of the field stood the players of lowly Cumberland College. Heisman was intent on building his team's reputation...and lured Cumberland to the game with a \$500 quarantee.





Tech had 8 All-South players. Cumberland had 8 players who had never even played football before. Even the trip down to Atlanta had been a disaster for Cumberland who arrived with only 16 players. They accidentally left three at a rest stop outside Nashville.

When the game began, Ga Tech scored 63 points in the first quarter, averaging a TD every 1:20. The game was full of tension and drama...but not because there was any doubt who would win....People wondered aloud in the stands....Could the Cumberland players be convinced to finish the game?

The Cumberland coach paced the sidelines, exhorting his team to "hang in there for Cumberland's \$500." They did, and with it collected the dubious honor of the worst loss in college football history: 222-0.

Nobody likes to lose...especially to lose big.

For unto us a child is **born**, to **us a son** is given **Isaiah 9**:6a "He is as truly-born, as certainly a child, as any other man that ever lived upon the face of the earth. This child was truly born, born as any other child was born, born as any other man that ever lived upon the face of this earth. He is therefore born fully human just as any child would be. This baby, however, is God's Son, he is not just born, but given. This little Child was the Promised Messiah given to mankind by a loving God. This baby was the Son of God. Given because God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. This child who now is the centerpiece of our faith, wrapped in swaddling clothes in Bethlehem's manger has been given to us. He has been given to us who are born again through His birth, death and resurrection. He has been given to us as an unmerited gift of a loving God. WHAT A GIFT!
